METHOD OF SELECTION:

Selection will be through written test and interview of shortlisted candidates based on performance in the written test.

Candidates are required to print the call letter and comply with the instructions indicated therein. Please note that call letters will not be sent through e-mail or through conventional mail.

Candidates, whose applications are accepted through the process of submission of online applications, are eligible to attend the written test at the respective centre. The call letters will be uploaded on the website on 12.06.2010 **at 1400 hours (tentative)**.

THE WRITTEN TEST WILL BE HELD ON 27.06.2010 (Sunday)

The written test will be held at Bangalore, Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Guwahati centres. Candidates should choose the test centre nearest to their place of correspondence.

The written test will consist of Objective type questions from basic Engineering subjects, in the respective disciplines / specializations and General Aptitude. The list of candidates short-listed in the written test for interview, will tentatively appear on the BEL website. They will be required to appear for an interview for final selection. The results of selection will be available on the BEL website through query mode.
