There are several examples of the 'senses' being catered to, to excite required responses. As we very well know, the cow is made to release her milk flow through the activation of the senses of sight or touch. How well we know how aroma works in favour of the relish in eating some food stuffs! The air conditioning inside the vehicle one travels, when matched to the greenery outside is so much more satisfying, as against a dreary landscape through which one passes! An example that stimulated my curiosity remarkably was the reported design of a method to stimulate scratching of an amputated member, when the itch would not go away because of the nerves still running through the body of the amputee

The atmosphere or environment or personal space is going to be a primary stimulant for the output of individuals and groups of humans and if settings of all contexts like study, reading, thinking, play, relaxation, sleep, work etc can all be augmented appropriately, such an engineering may result in more output from the humankind.
